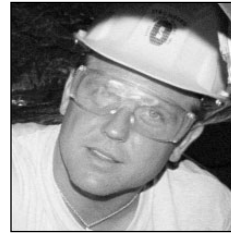

Partly because of outsourcing, we've lost millions of good jobs in the past three years, but George W. Bush still says "this economy is strong, and growing stronger." Creating Good Jobs

JOHN KERRY will create good jobs by providing tax breaks to expand manufacturing jobs in the United States and end the giveaways that encourage corporations to move U.S. jobs abroad. (*Associated Press*, 3/25/04)

GEORGE W. BUSH has lost 1.8 million private-sector jobs since he became president, and he supports tax breaks that reward companies more for shipping jobs overseas. Protecting Overtime Pay

JOHN KERRY supports workers' right to overtime pay; co-sponsored legislation to prevent the Bush administration from taking away the right to overtime pay from millions of workers. (S. Amdt. 1580, 2003)

GEORGE W. BUSH opposes workers' right to overtime pay. His administration changed the rules governing overtime pay, which could result in at least 6 million workers losing their right to overtime pay beginning on Aug. 23. (*Federal Register*, vol. 69, no. 79, 04/23/04; Economic Policy Institute)
