## **BMWED SECOND REGULAR CONVENTION DELEGATES CONVERGE ON LAS VEGAS**

Las Vegas, NV – Delegates to the BMWED Second Regular Convention arrived in Las Vegas this weekend in time to register their credentials. Delegates representing nearly 500 BMWED Local Lodges will be attending the Convention.

The delegates will be attending the quadrennial meetings for at least three days beginning Monday, June 21. They will be choosing their elected representatives and charting the BMWED's course for the next four years.

BMWED National Division President Freddie Simpson was on hand Sunday to personally welcome the delegates. "I look forward to meeting with our elected delegates who have been chosen to represent the interest of the men and women who are the backbone of our Organization.
