I am pleased to advise that, pursuant to BMW Resolution # 51, one annual scholarship in the amount of \$1,500.00 will be awarded in November 2004 to a BMW member or an eligible dependent, with preference given to applicants enrolled or planning to enroll in an accredited college or university in pursuit of labor-related studies.

Enclosed for your information and distribution as you deem necessary is a copy of a two-page document outlining eligibility criteria, application procedures, and the award selection criteria. Also enclosed is a two-page application form to be submitted by members and eligible dependents applying for the annual BMW Scholarship. These four pages will constitute the entire "BMW Scholarship packet" for the 2004 scholarship award.

A notice announcing the annual scholarship will be published in the next edition of the BMW Journal.
