Four separate awareness level hazardous materials training courses (6-8 hours) for rail workers and community personnel will be conducted at the Carteret Fire Headquarters in Carteret, NJ. Training is funded by the National Institute of Environmental Health Sciences (NIEHS), and conducted in cooperation with seven rail unions. Training courses address OSHA and DOT requirements for hazardous materials transportation, and include:

- ★ Hazardous materials recognition and identification;
- ★ Use of the *2004 Emergency Response Guidebook*;
- ★ Using and comparing resources;
- ★ Chemical properties and health effects of hazardous materials; and
- ★ Workplace/community emergency response plans.

Rail workers who participate in one of these training courses are eligible for a stipend of \$110. Completed registration forms should be faxed, mailed or e-mailed to the Hazmat office as soon as possible. Online registration is also available at <http://www.hazmatgmc.org>.
